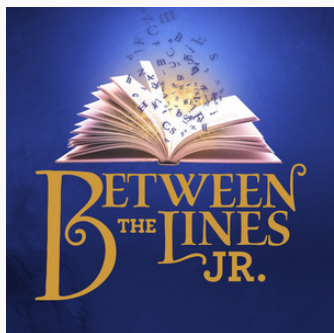

Rehearsal & Performance Schedule

Rehearsals begin the week of September 14 and run for 10 weeks.

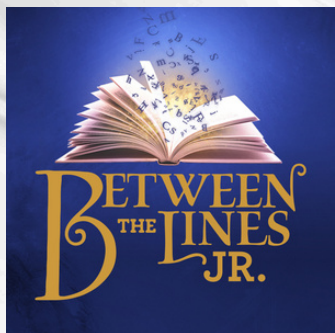
Families may choose to register for either:

Kidlet A (Mondays) or Kidlet B (Wednesdays) from 4:00–4:45 PM.

- Weeks 1–9 will take place at Studio 89.
- No regular rehearsals will be held on Monday, October 12th or Wednesday, October 14th for Thanksgiving Break.
- Week 10/11 will be final dress rehearsal at the Crystal Ridge Community Centre times and dates TBD.

Production rehearsals will culminate in a final performance run, where the Kidlets will take the stage as butterflies and bugs in two professional productions of Between The Lines Jr.!

- Kidlet A will perform the weekend of Nov 27 & 28
- Kidlet B will perform the weekend of Dec 4 & 5

Actors Ages 8-14yrs

This ensemble class is designed for performers who want to be part of the onstage world without auditioning for featured roles, bringing the School Students to life through energetic group scenes, ensemble songs, and choreography. Featured in the charming number "Talking to Oliver" and additional ensemble moments, actors will help weave together the everyday world that leads into the storybook adventure. Perfect for new and developing performers, this class builds confidence, strengthens performance skills, and celebrates the magic of teamwork and storytelling.

Rehearsal & Performance Schedule

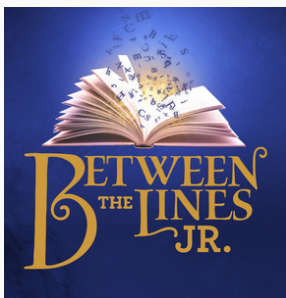
Rehearsals begin the week of September 14 and run for 10 weeks.

- Week 10/11 will be final dress rehearsal at the Crystal Ridge Community Centre times and dates TBD.

Audition Required

Actors Ages 8-11yrs

Actors in the Jr. Leads class will develop as confident triple threats while stepping into featured roles of the Fairy Tale Kingdom. Performers will strengthen their acting, vocal, and dance skills through character work, choreography, and scenes. This class is recommended for actors who feel comfortable on stage and have prior experience in singing, acting, or dancing.

****Select performers cast in larger roles and may be asked to stay to rehearse with the Main Cast on select dates. Main Cast tuition applies to those offered larger roles and will be adjusted after auditions. Actors not successful after auditions will be offered an ensemble role in ensemble. Tuition will be adjusted after auditions****

Rehearsal & Performance Schedule

Families can choose to register for either group:

Jr Leads A (Mondays 6:15–7:15 PM) or Jr. Leads B (Wednesdays 6:15–7:15 PM).

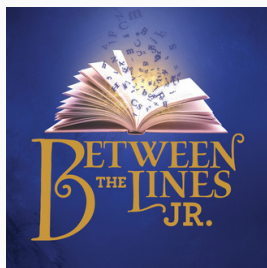
Those cast in larger featured roles including Frump, Princess Seraphima & Troll may be asked to stay later on select rehearsal dates.

Actors Ages 12-17yrs

****ACTORS 12-17 yrs wanting to audition for Delilah, Prince Oliver, Jules, Mrs. Winx, Allie McAndrews or any other MAIN CAST ROLE should register in this class****

Actors in the Main Cast class will dive deep into the world of Between the Lines Jr., taking on the show's most iconic roles, including Delilah, Prince Oliver, Jules, Mrs. Winx and other unforgettable characters who drive the story. This is an intensive, performance-focused experience where actors are challenged to make bold choices, build layered characters, and tell the story with clarity and confidence. Over 10 weeks, they'll refine their acting, vocal, and dance skills through detailed scene work, character development, choreography, and blocking, all while learning what it truly means to lead a cast. Expect growth, teamwork, and a whole lot of fearless storytelling. **Our Main Cast is recommended for experienced actors who feel confident on stage and have previous experience in theatre.**

****Actors not offered a role in our MAIN CAST will be offered roles in our Jr. Leads or our Ensemble classes based on age and suitability. Actors cast as lead roles that will be participating in 6 productions will pay an additional \$55 for extra rehearsals/performances. Tuition amounts will be adjusted after auditions****

Rehearsal & Performance Schedule

PLEASE NOTE: Not every MAIN CAST actor will be required at every rehearsal.

Rehearsals begin with a script read on Wednesday Sept 9 and regular rehearsals begin the week of September 14 and run for 10/11 weeks, depending on show weekend. Actors cast as Leads in the MAIN CAST need to be available for rehearsals Mondays and Wednesdays from 7:30pm-9:30pm. Supporting roles will be split into Cast A and Cast B and may not be required every Mon and Wed. Once we have cast our show, an additional calendar will be sent out to fill in any TBD's.

- Weeks 1-9 will take place at Studio 89.
- No regular rehearsals will be held on Monday, October 12th for Thanksgiving
- Week 10/11 will be final dress rehearsal at the Crystal Ridge Community Centre times and dates TBD.

Production rehearsals will culminate in a final performance run, where the main cast will take the stage in a production run of Between the Lines Jr! Our MAIN CAST will perform in 3 shows on either Nov 27/28, Dec 4/5 with some lead roles performing in 6 shows on both weekends.

Between The Lines Jr. Audition Info

All auditions will take place at Studio 89:

Thursday August 6-Saturday August 8

Each actor 12+ yrs will be given an individual time slot.

Actors 8-11yrs will audition in a small group.

Read through the audition requirements in the package we will provide. All information regarding song/scene choices will be included. Actors must first be registered on our Studio Pro Portal in either:

Jr. Leads (actors ages 8-11yrs)

Main Cast (12+yrs)

After you have registered & paid your costume deposit, we will contact you directly to fill out an audition form and set up your audition time slot.

Audition Notes

This season for Between the Lines Jr. we ask that actors 12+ auditioning for the Main Cast come prepared with a various selection of song choices (found in this guide) regardless of the character you are auditioning for. We are interested in seeing your vocal versatility for this show!

This season for Between the Lines Jr., we encourage our potential Jr. Lead actors to come into their audition with confidence and preparation.

Auditions will take place in small groups, with featured roles including Princess Seraphina, Frump, Troll, and Lady-in-Waiting being cast from the Jr. auditions. If your actor hopes to be considered for one of these speaking roles, we encourage them to learn their material well and make bold, thoughtful choices that allow their personality and performance to shine.

Tuition Fees Explained

Costume Fee \$95 (+HST) Due at registration

This non-refundable costume fee will secure your spot in our production & go towards the purchase of your costume for the performance. Actors will receive their costume for our production approx. weeks 8/9 of rehearsals.

Costume Bag Fee \$30 (+HST) Due September 14th, 2026

To be added to new DTRH actors ONLY once registered. Actors will receive their costumes in a re-usable DTRH garment bag that will keep them safe & secure. If you choose to join future sessions, you will be able to re-use for the next production & this costume fee will be reduced. Past DTRH actors must return their costume bags and hanger from previous productions or be charged an additional fee. Returning actors do not need to pay this fee unless they have lost their bag.

**ALL Tuition fees are due on or before
Monday August 31st, 2026**

***Because ensemble & leads vary in pricing, please do not pay your full tuition fee until after you have completed auditions & your actor has been cast in a Leads class. If your actor is given a lead character and will be performing in 6 shows, extra rehearsal times will be provided and an additional \$55 will be added to your studio pro account.*

Script Fee \$20 (HST INCLUDED) Due 1st day of rehearsal

This fee only applies to our Main cast & some Jr. Lead roles

Tickets to our Production

Tickets for Between The Lines Jr. will go on sale in early October.
